Designed for the committed tournament players, the **Top Gun** program is for athletes serious about competitive development.

Participants must hold a current USTA sectional or district ranking, or compete on a high school varsity team. Final approval by SVC professionals is required prior to enrollment. The full summer session includes **36 classes** totaling **108 hours** of high performance training, led by five accredited tennis professionals.
